This guide is intended for one appointed member of your group who may wish to make dining reservations, or for those who prefer to focus primarily on visiting the locations, in an abbreviated experience.

If reservations are required or recommended at a location, that information will be noted. Otherwise, walk-up options are usually available, and you can decide what works best for your group's schedule. For those visiting during busy seasons, securing reservations in advance is highly recommended.

If you'd rather keep the mystery alive for everyone, avoid reading ahead. The experience can still be fully completed without sitting down at each dining location.

Do not read ahead if you wish to keep the locations a surprise.

About: BaseLine Tap House is a laid-back beer and wine spot in Disney's Hollywood Studios, offering a rotating selection of craft beers, ciders, and wines alongside simple, shareable bites. The space feels more workshop than bar, with an emphasis on quality ingredients, careful selection, and drinks. It's an easy place to pause, compare flavors, and appreciate careful craft.

Preferred Provisions:

-  *Food:* Bavarian Pretzel, California Cheese and Charcuterie Plate
-  *With Alcohol:* Create-Your-Own Beer Flight, Coronado Brewing Co. Superfruit Hard Cider
-  *Without Alcohol:* Wild Strawberry Lemonade

Tip: The Bavarian pretzel comes with both beer-cheese fondue and spicy mustard, but you can always ask to swap the mustard for a second side of cheese.

Tip: Inside has detailed décor that hints at the mysterious disappearances of past magicians, as well as a few hidden Mickeys.

-  *With Alcohol:* Seasonal Wine Flight, Wine Bar George Old Fashioned
-  *Without Alcohol:* Orgeat Lemonade

Tip: If you can't get a reservation, check out the walk up area outside (The Basket), where you can still grab small bites and drinks.





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
